This does not include personal accident insurance. You must have your own accident and ambulance cover and the association takes no responsibility for any events that may occur.

Your workshop ticket includes: participation in one workshop, entry to presentations and the festival site and related activities.

The number of workshop places are strictly limited. Please limit your workshop bookings to ONE workshop per person.

If you are not a current member of NSW Canyoning Association, you must select the NON-MEMBER price for the workshop/festival ticket. This ticket price will include 12 months membership to the NSW Canyoning Association from time of purchase. (Membership is a pre - requisite for attending one of our workshops, for insurance purposes).
